



Relentless Youth Retreat Policies and Expectations

1. **No Cell Phones/Electronic Devices** – Students will NOT be allowed to bring cell phones on the Summer 2022 Youth Retreat. Parents can contact Chris Reitz (231-884-9665) if they need to reach their child. Additionally, we ask that students not bring tablets, portable game systems, or other electronics that would take away from the experience of the retreat. The goal is to disconnect from distractions!
2. **No Pairing Off With the Opposite Sex** – Students are not to be found in pairs in secluded areas (this applies to guy/girl pairs).
3. **No Public Displays of Affection** – Students are not to be holding hands, kissing, or performing any other type of romantic physical contact.
4. **No Bullying** – We will not tolerate bullying behavior. This includes name calling, pushing, shoving, hitting, or any type of mean behavior towards another student. Any bullying situations will be reported to parents immediately.
5. **No Foul Language/Crude Joking** – Parents will be made aware of any language or crude joking that takes place.
6. **No Drugs** - If we find out about students using drugs during the youth retreat, parents will be made aware and told to come pick up their student from the retreat immediately. This includes vapes of any kind.
7. **Respect Leaders** – We expect all students to obey the youth leaders throughout the weekend. Any behavior issues will be dealt with accordingly.
